Question 1

In annex 2 - Tender specifications, section 8.3 Technical and Professional capacity, you specify that for services provided to contracting authorities, the tenderers should provide certificates issued by the competent authority. Could you please confirm that "Contracting authority" means "Public sector organisation" and therefore no certificates are required from private clients.

Answer 1

Yes, your understanding is correct.

Question 2

In annex 2 - Tender specifications, section 8.3 Technical and Professional capacity, you specify that for services provided to contracting authorities, the tenderers should provide certificates issued by the competent authority. Could the tenderers provide copies of the audit reports on the financial statements instead of certificates as these reports are evidences that the services were actually provided?

Answer 2

As an alternative to certificates of performance, the tenderers can provide audit reports on the financial statements along with a proof that those reports were made public (ex. link to published reports) or accepted by auditee.
