She served in five Estonian governments as:

Keit Pentus-Rosimannus was responsible for coordinating the final phase of the EU's long-term budget planning for 2021-2027.

She also initiated the first Estonian national climate strategy.

Estonian parliament 2007-2011; 2015-2021

Keit Pentus-Rosimannus was first elected in 2007, and was subsequently re-elected three times (2011, 2015, and 2019).

She served as a member of the finance, European affairs and foreign affairs committees.
