The European Court of Auditors is the **GUARDIAN** of the EU's finances throughout all EU Member States and around the world

are helping the environment



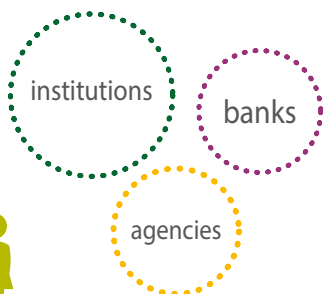
- **Jobs & growth**

are really being delivered

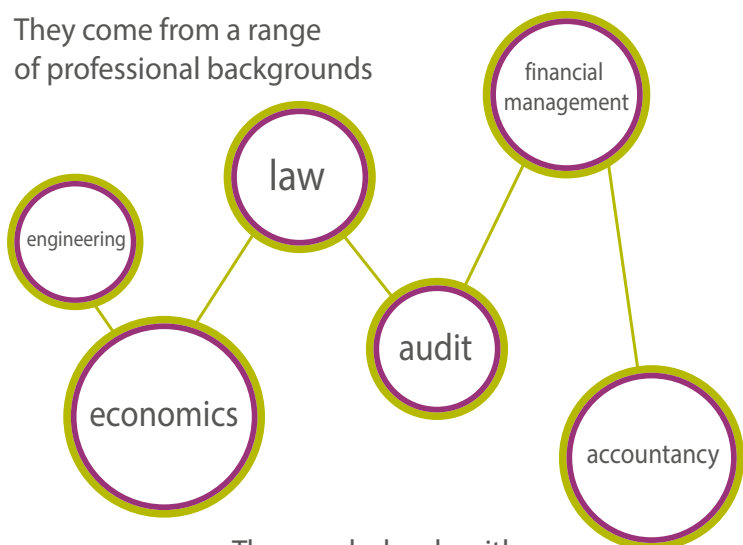


Who are the EU Auditors?
