



Līga Kļaviņa has dedicated much of her professional career in service to design of national and international financial policy and rules in various key positions within the Ministry of Finance of Latvia and as Latvian representative in relevant intergovernmental fora. She has established herself as one of key policy experts in financial crisis management, in particular, in record time steering the country out of the prolonged fall-out from the 2007-2008 Global financial crisis and demanding international assistance programs.
