Ramona Strugariu is a Member of the European Parliament elected in Romania in 2019 and is affiliated to the Renew Europe Group. She is a member of the Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home affairs and a substitute in the Committee on Budgetary Control and the Committee on Foreign Affairs, as well as a Vice-chair of the Delegation to the EU-Moldova Association Parliamentary Committee and Chair of the Committee on Energy Security within the Euronest Parliamentary Assembly.

She studied Law at the University 'Al. I. Cuza' from Iaşi, Romania, where she also obtained her Master degree in European Law. After working as legal adviser and playing an active role in civil society organisations, she came to Brussels where she worked as an adviser in the European Parliament for several years.
