Jean-Christophe Laloux holds a Commercial Engineering degree from the Catholic University of Leuven, a Post Graduate in Management (magna cum laude) from the University of Ghent, and a Master of Business Administration (Distinction) from the Kellogg School of Management, Northwestern University - USA.

He joined the Bank in 1999 after having worked about 6 years as a management consultant for PriceWaterhouseCoopers and the Boston Consulting Group.

He started in the Bank as a loan officer for lending operations in the Benelux.

He then became senior venture capital officer with the European Investment Fund, covering Benelux, Italy and France. Subsequently, he spent two and a half years as Advisor to the President and was then appointed Head of Special Operations for the Mediterranean Partner Countries.

On 1 January 2009, he became Head of the Southeast Europe Department, then Head of the Western Europe Department. Between May 2012 and March 2014, he was Director General in charge of Personnel. He is Director General, Deputy Head of Operations since April 2014.
